Cançonier is a Bay Area-based early music group devoted to medieval repertoire from the 12th to the 15th centuries, and occasionally including traditional music from related regions (Scandinavia, the Balkans, and the Middle East). Created by multi-instrumentalist **Tim Rayborn** and recorder virtuoso **Annette Bauer** as a duo, the group also features the talents of Bay Area favorite **Shira Kammen** on bowed strings, and the beautiful voice of **Phoebe Jevtovic**.

The group is the medieval ensemble-in-residence at **Music Sources, Center for Historically Informed Performances, Inc.** This organization, based in Berkeley, CA, is a non-profit resource institution, a facility, and an educational center. It is a home base for the community (local, regional, national, and international) of professionals and promising students devoted to the historically informed performance of music from the Middle Ages to the early nineteenth century (1100 to 1850). The building showcases a collection of antique and replica keyboards from four centuries, and the library specializes in texts and scores from the 16th to the early 19th centuries. Its annual concert series features distinguished local and international artists.
